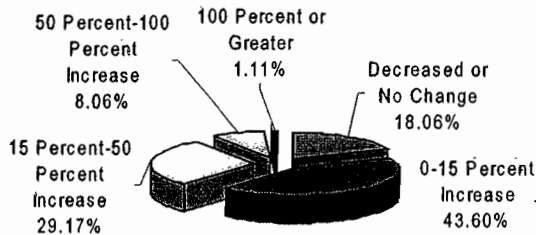

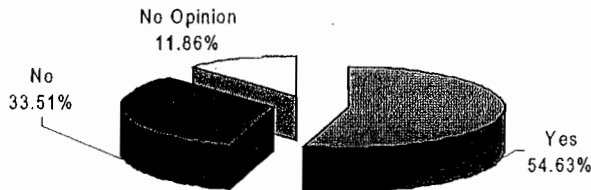

Below are the results of Rep. Cleo Duncan's 2008 Legislative Survey, based on responses from constituents, who replied both by mail and online:

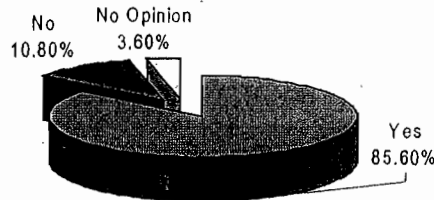
1. How did the property taxes on your home change in the last year?



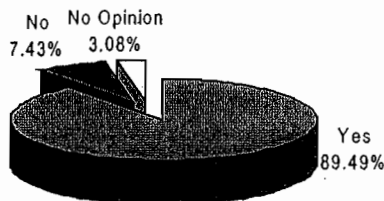
2. Should Indiana eliminate all property taxes, replacing the revenue with increases in the sales and income taxes?



3. Do you support requiring voter approval for large local construction projects that would be paid for by local property taxes? (i.e. jails, schools, and libraries)

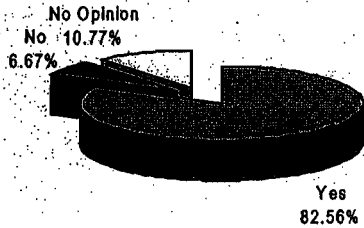


4. Do you support requiring a two-thirds super-majority vote by the General Assembly in order to raise taxes?

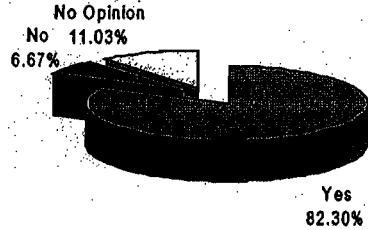

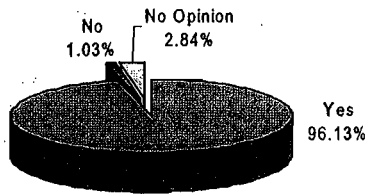
5. Do you support limiting spending increases to the state budget to the rate of inflation?



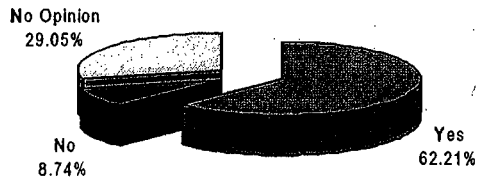
8. Do you favor the expansion of the referendum process in Indiana to allow voters to have more input on important issues at elections?



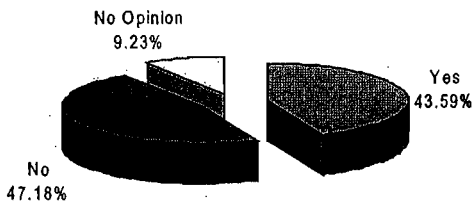
6. In order to prevent illegal aliens from receiving state benefits, should the state verify identification before granting state benefits?
