RESOLUTION NO. 2000-1

**"A Resolution approving the City of Greensburg Redevelopment Commission's Resolution No. 2000-1, the plan commission's approving order and related matters, including repealing all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith."**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Greensburg Redevelopment Commission (the "Commission"), acting as the Redevelopment Commission of the City of Greensburg, Indiana, pursuant to certain provisions of Indiana Code 36-7-14 and 36-7-25 and other applicable laws (collectively, the "Act") adopted its Resolution 2000-1, on February 14, 2000 (the "Declaratory Resolution")(which Declaratory Resolution is on file in the records of the Commission and is incorporated herein by this reference) to establish of a geographical area in the redevelopment district (the "Redevelopment District") of the City of Greensburg, Indiana (the "City") as an economic development area to be known as the "SR 3 Corridor Development Area Economic Development Area" (the "Area") and propose an economic development plan (the "Plan") for the Area; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Declaratory Resolution, the Commission has determined all of the Area should be designated an allocation area (the "Allocation Area") for the purposes of distribution and allocation of property taxes under the provisions of Indiana Code 36-7-14-39 and Indiana Code 36-7-14-41 of the Act; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Declaratory Resolution, the Commission recommended to the Council that the Council provide by resolution that the additional credit available under Indiana Code 36-7-14-39.5 (subject to the limitations contained therein) be given to the taxpayers in the Allocation Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Declaratory Resolution, including the supporting data, has been submitted to the City's plan commission (or other responsible body) (the "Plan Commission") and the Plan Commission has issued its written order (the "Order") approving the Declaratory Resolution and the Plan;

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council now finds that all conditions precedent to the adoption of this resolution have been complied with in accordance with the provisions of the Act; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG, INDIANA:**

1. That the determination that the Area is economic development area (as defined in the Act) is hereby approved.

2. That the Order approving the Declaratory Resolution and the Plan is hereby approved.

3. That the additional credit available under Indiana Code 36-7-14-39.5 (subject to the limitations contained therein) be given to the taxpayers in the Allocation Area.

4. That the establishment of the Area as economic development area (as defined in the Act) and the Allocation Area as an allocation area (as defined in the Act), is hereby found and determined to be in the public interest of the City and its citizens and is a proper public purpose for which this Council agrees to cooperate with the Commission to assist in fulfilling the requirements of the Act.

5. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
