

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-31

(Amending Ordinance No. 1991-10) An Ordinance Designating a Certain Intersection as Controlled by an Automatic Traffic Signal in Greensburg, Indiana

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Greensburg Indiana has the right to designate certain traffic control devices, intersections, stop intersections, yield areas and parking control within the City of Greensburg, Indiana, pursuant to Indiana Code

Section 1. In the interest of safety to all persons, it shall be unlawful for any person to violate the following Automatic Traffic Signal restrictions:

North Lincoln Street at Montgomery Road.

Section 2. That any person convicted for the violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

Section 3. That any fines collected for violations of this Ordinance shall be deposited to the City of Greensburg General Fund.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and the publication thereof.
