

ORDINANCE 2007-07-13

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH AND ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR GARAGE SALES, YARD SALES, AND OF UNUSED OR UNWANTED ITEM

BE IT THERE ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG

SECTION 1. This ordinance shall govern the control of Garage sales, yard sales, and sales of unused or unwanted items within the City of Greensburg, Indiana.

SECTION 2. *Permit.* Prior to the occurrence of a sale, the resident or sponsoring group shall be required to apply for a permit for such sale on forms provided at the City Hall. No fee shall be imposed for the issuance of such permit. The permit shall be displayed at the sale site during the time of the sale. The permit can be obtained at the Mayor' s Office at City Hall.

SECTION 3. *Restriction.* A resident or institution shall be allowed to hold no more than two (2) sales on the premises for no more than three (3) consecutive days per sale, in any calendar year.

SECTION 4. *Signage.* Signage for a sale shall be limited to one accessory sign not to exceed nine (9) square feet in area which sign shall not be displayed until the day sale and shall be removed forthwith upon expiration of the sale permit. One sign may be posted on your property. No signage or notices may be posted on or nailed to telephone/utility poles, or signs placed on street corners.

SECTION 5. *Penalty.* If a permit is not obtained or a permit is lost a \$25 fee will be enforced for a new permit.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect on this ____ day of ____ 2007.
